The Group:

The School:

The English International School in Moscow (EIS) has 3 campuses, located in the East, West and South West of this vibrant and spectacular city. The first campus – Moscow East - opened in September 2006 in response to Moscow's growing demand for international schools of outstanding quality, providing British style education for expatriate and local students aged 3 to 18 years. The East campus is a 17 minute metro ride to the heart of the city – Red Square. The West campus opened in 2012 located in a lovely and prestigious residential area to the West of Moscow near Kutuzovskiy Prospect. Moscow West is for children 3 – 12 years of age. The third campus – Moscow South West - opened in 2014 providing education for children aged 3 to 13. It is situated in the prestigious residential and diplomatic area near the Leninskiy Prospekt and not far from Prospekt Vernadskogo.

All 3 campuses have excellent records of academic achievement. They are valued by parents as family-orientated schools, where individuals matter. These are truly international schools, with over 30 nationalities represented, but the language used in the school and in all lessons is English. The schools work with embassies, corporate partners and the large international population in Moscow, to ensure they remain at the heart of the community and are warm and welcoming centres of academic excellence.

Each of the three schools has its own Principal who sets the tone and direction of his or her institution but there is also a strong collegial leadership style in the working relations between

schools. Legal, financial, and administrative support services are provided to all schools by the local Director of EIS. The EIS Moscow marketing strategy is also collaboratively developed centrally with input from the team of Principals.
