Job Purpose

To ensure a high quality of learning experience for students in the absence of their regular teacher

Main Responsibilities

- 1. Work with staff prior to planned absence to ensure continuity of curriculum experience
- 2. Supervise classes, groups and activities in the absence of their regular teacher
- 3. Prepare resources in collaboration with Curriculum areas
- 4. Maintain accurate records of cover work
- 5. Deliver learning activities to students as individuals and groups
- 6. Organise work for tutorials and lessons in liaison with Subject Leaders and subject teachers
- 7. Provide feedback on the quality of students' learning experienced in cover lessons, tutorials and activities e.g. school visits
- 8. Working under the direction of the Senior Leadership Team to provide supervision in the school's Seclusion Unit
- 9. Liaise with Teaching Assistants regarding the needs of individual students
- 10. Mentor students
- II. Invigilate internal and external examinations when required
- 12. Be aware of and comply with policies and procedures e.g. Behaviour Management, Child Protection and Health & Safety
- 13. Supervise students on visits and enrichment activities as required
- 14. Attend staff meetings
- 15. Any other duties commensurate with the role.
