## Your roles and responsibilities:

- Promote the highest possible standards of achievement in mathematics for all students (including those for whom we receive a pupil premium, or those that have additional educational needs)
- Ensure that students achieve or exceed their targets in mathematics
- Develop a vibrant and exciting mathematics curriculum for all learners
- Raise the quality of curriculum and teaching by defining and implementing appropriate improvement targets in mathematics and having a clear long term strategy
- Lead, manage and develop staff and visitors who contribute to the teaching of mathematics
- Develop an interest in, and enthusiasm for, the mathematics in all learners including coordinating a range of extracurricular opportunities

## As Curriculum Leader for Mathematics your department must have:

- Clear, written aims, plans and objectives
- An agreed Raising Achievement Plan
- Agreed schemes of work which include all students
- An agreed SEF evaluating strengths and weaknesses
- High quality assessment and feedback
- Clear, simple records on pupils' progress
- Analysis of standards and how well different groups are doing
- Regular, minuted meetings
- Planned professional development
- Well deployed resources, including support staff
- Plentiful, accessible and high quality resources, often available online
