The successful candidate will have strong credentials, both breadth and depth of knowledge in the subject(s), a high level of English language ability, and a clear enthusiasm for developing the abilities and understanding of our students. We have modern and well-equipped facilities, with interactive whiteboards as standard. There is a dynamic staff culture at the school with strong professional development which has a national reputation.
