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Communication: We have been working hard to make the website work for you and also to comply with DfE (Department for Education) standards. We have done this by trying to make it easy to find your way from one page to another and that information you need is there and flows logically. If you have noticed anything that we can improve on, please let us know! The governor responsible for communication works closely with school staff and is monitoring how successful our methods of communication are and will report to the full governing body termly.

**Safeguarding:** includes a large number of policies in school that are designed to keep children safe in education. Staff have recently updated the **Behaviour policy**, with new reward systems in place as well as a new reporting and recording system.

**Attendance** matters greatly for us at Wirksworth Junior School. **Punctuality** and attendance have been a focus for staff during the first few weeks of term and this will continue throughout the school year. Staff are working with children on rewards for attendance and will work with families who need our support, to ensure that children attend school so that they can achieve their best. The governor for safeguarding will now monitor these half termly and there will be a report to the full governing body on how the policies are being implemented and how effective they are being.

Progress and achievement of children receiving Pupil Premium funding is important to us, as with all children. We have worked with staff to help them create more detailed action plans for how we will spend the funding to support the learning and achievement of those children. We employed the help of a specialist consultant for three days and we have a named governor working with staff; scrutinising, monitoring and reporting to the full governing body about the effectiveness of work undertaken.

We are continuing to support Mrs Taylor as Acting Head Teacher and the other staff in school. Sue Stack, Consultant Head Teacher is continuing to provide leadership support whilst we plan how to make a more permanent leadership appointment.

And Finally.....I would like to say how nice it has been to see parents in the playground. It feels like there is a real buzz and it's an opportunity to make important contacts for school staff and parents.....long may it continue!
