Introduction

The Mackay School is the second oldest British international school in South America, with an impressive history as a Scottish-influenced, artisan-founded school in 1857. It retains a strong and proud link with its founders and British culture and heritage, set within the rich landscape of the Chilean Valparaiso region. There are rightly ambitious plans for a new school location, designed to take advantage of its links with St Margaret's British Girls' School, build relationships with universities and develop its influence regionally, nationally and internationally.

The Location and the School

The Mackay School is a private, not-for-profit all through Nursery to Year 13 (UK system) school of 840 boys, in Viña del Mar, Chile's fourth largest city, in Valparaiso. It has a Mediterranean climate and has an attractive array of sandy beaches, including Renaca, (the current location of the school), Miramar, Las Salinas and Casino.

The great majority of the boys and the staff in the school are Chilean. It is a member of the Association of British Schools in Chile (ABS) and the Association of International Baccalaureate Schools in Chile (ACHBI).

Mackay is an International Baccalaureate (IB) World School, which is authorised for the PYP and Diploma programmes, and will be applying for the MYP in 2019. All Chilean schools have to follow national programmes, and all boys must take the PSU examination, an end of school leaving exam, which is the direct entry method for Chilean universities.

There is an English immersion system up until 5th grade and the PYP is taught in English. Mackay has three 'pillars' to its mission, aiming for academic excellence; bilingualism in English and Spanish and the participation in sport. Sport, especially rugby, is an important cultural aspect of the school.

In addition, Mackay has invested heavily in technology, and is a firm believer in trying to educate for the 21st century. There is a 'bring your own device' policy from 6th grade onwards.

articulated by the Board of Governors for their school and on a truly strategic scale.

This is a post for a capable, confident and experienced professional with a track record of educational success at an equivalent or similar level in a school. The school's rich British heritage needs to be reflected in the new Head – in manner and style, as well as in experience.
