Yew Chung International School – Hong Kong

YCIS–Hong Kong offers learning programs from infant, toddler and kindergarten through primary and secondary education. All campuses are located in a district near to residential areas and are accessible through a major public transportation hub. Both the Primary and Early Childhood Sections are divided into three campuses in close proximity to each other. Therefore, pupils are able to learn and develop in a spacious environment with similar age groups. The campus of the Secondary Section is newly built and equipped with new and advanced technology in both security and teaching aids. Around 1,800 students are currently studying in YCIS–Hong Kong.



Shanghai Campus

Yew Chung International School – Shanghai

In Puxi, the Hongqiao campus, is on the inner west side of Shanghai near the domestic airport; while the Gubei Campus, is located nearby. The campuses provide an attractive, high-tech learning and teaching environment. Our Pudong campus is uniquely situated in 10 residential houses standing alongside each other. The school is located in one of the most picturesque, secure and comfortable compounds in all of Shanghai. The children have access to unlimited grassed areas, purpose-built play structures, indoor and outdoor swimming pools, tennis, squash and basketball courts and a host of other facilities.



Beijing Campus

Yew Chung International School – Beijing

Located in Beijing's scenic Honglingjin Park, YCIS-Beijing is well equipped with two computer laboratories, three science laboratories, an English as an Additional Language (EAL) centre, an Intensive English Programme (IEP) centre, libraries in the Early Childhood Education, Primary and Secondary sections, a gymnasium, a cafeteria, and outdoor activity and play areas. Additionally, other sports facilities located in close proximity to the school are also utilized. While maintaining a standard of excellence, YCIS-Beijing promotes creative expression, individual growth, and a spirit of service to the community.



Chongqing Campus

Yew Chung International School – Chongqing

YCIS-Chongqing is the first international school in Chongqing City. The Chongqing Municipal Government strongly encouraged the establishment of the school and the official registration was completed in September 2001. In winter 2007, YCIS-Chongqing moved to its new state-of-the-art campus situated at Chongqing International School Garden, which is a new area in the city's Northern New Economic Development Zone. It is strategically located between the airport and the city centre near the city's main road - with easy access just off the airport expressway.



Qingdao Campus

YCIS-Silicon Valley offers the community a fully bilingual environment throughout every school day with classes from Preschool through Grade 5. In addition, we continue our mission in bilingual education through our after-school program for YCIS-SV and other students with a fully Mandarin-based program that allows students to reinforce their language skills in a supervised extra-curricular structure. In 2008, YCIS-SV Preschool was named the Best of Mountain View Preschool by the US Local Business Association.

The Yew Chung Education Foundation has been providing all-round early childhood, primary, and secondary programs to young people in Greater China for more than 75 years. Our programs focus on preparing students to be responsible citizens with a sense of personal and social responsibility in the emerging globalized world and, based on the moral and spiritual values of Christianity, to develop students' abilities by using the best elements of Eastern and Western traditions and culture. At Yew Chung International Schools, we are committed to fostering students' spiritual, academic, physical, social, and emotional development. We nurture an open outlook in each student, and they are encouraged to develop their talents and contribute actively to society.

All YCIS schools use the YCIS international curriculum based on the National Curriculum for England, IGCSE, IB Diploma, Character First Education, and a Chinese Language and Culture Curriculum. Instruction is conducted in English, and Chinese - which is given equal importance - is offered to every child in a bilingual curriculum. YCIS is famous for its unique Chinese language and cultural program for native, second, or third language speakers, and the program for character building is based on the best traditions of east and west (including the Christian faith).

Each Early Childhood Education (ECE) and primary class is staffed with fully-trained western and Chinese co-teachers. There are two semesters in a year: August-December, January-June. Enrolment is open to all expatriate nationalities based on interview, admission tests and school reports. Year 2 to Year 6 students are assessed from England.

The IB Diploma Program (Y12/13) is available for students who desire a high-quality external educational diploma for university entrance around the world. Students are also prepared for SAT, TOEFL, and IELTS language tests.

Following the expansion of the Foundation in Greater China, educators joining Yew Chung have the opportunity to develop their teaching career in rapidly growing areas in which teaching and learning are equally important. Teachers at Yew Chung are involved with students and parents in special activities like: artists-in-residence, world classroom, open day, careers day, international cultural weeks, parents' day, in-service days, and graduation trips, to name a few activities.

To deliver the teaching curriculum and foster student development, Yew Chung campuses provide sufficient regular classrooms, art rooms, music rooms, laboratories, and libraries, along with other facilities including an auditorium, chapel, gymnasium, swimming pool, basketball court, cafeteria, and covered playground.
