

## **Appointment of Head of Kabete International School**

### **We are seeking to appoint a Head of Kabete International School for September 2018.**

The school (often referred to locally as Kabete Kindergarten or simply “KK”) is set in delightful grounds in Lower Kabete, where it has been since 1979 under the guidance and leadership of Mrs Ailsa Wood. There has always been a strong link between KIS and Peponi House and this link has been further strengthened in recent years. Mr Robert Blake, the Headmaster of Peponi House, will be leading the recruitment of the Head.

KIS has a deserved reputation for giving children a fine start to their school careers and we wish to build on this success and reputation. We seek to appoint a Head who can maintain the traditional values that underpin this very successful school, while at the same time embracing recent developments in teaching and learning.

Children may start at KIS from the age of two and all leave after the end of Year One, when they are six. Most children go on to join Peponi House but some children will go on to some of Nairobi’s other excellent prep schools. Children are given a very sound foundation in all aspects of school life, a grounding that serves them very well as they make the move up to “big school”. As well as everything that one would expect from the early years and foundation stage, children have the opportunity to take part in a variety of sports, learn to swim, take ballet lessons, enjoy music and generally thrive.
