



Information about the School

Bay Primary School

Bay Primary School provides an outstanding environment for learning and promotes positive attitudes to education, the environment and the community.

<u>AIMS</u>

Our aim is that children should benefit from their education by developing alert enquiring minds a sense of purpose imagination perseverance high expectations confidence and integrity independence self discipline.

Bay Primary School opened in September 2002. The school was built as part of the Bridlington Schools Private Finance Initiative, a partnership between East Riding of Yorkshire Council and Jarvis Plc. The school building offers good design features and the potential within the Private Finance Initiative for a high standard of maintenance and upkeep.



Bay Primary is a community school for 420 pupils aged between four and eleven years of age. The school is a 2 form entry Primary providing education from the Foundation Stage through to the end of Key Stage 2. Bay Primary School was rated 'Good' by Ofsted in May 2015. "This is a happy, inclusive and rapidly improving school". "Pupils have a clear sense of right and wrong and are prepared well for life in modern Britain". Bay Primary School has achieved Investors in People accreditation in 2016.



Staff, pupils, governors and parents are proud of Bay Primary School and are committed to continuing the progress and high standards already achieved. The school participates in local sports and arts events for schools whenever possible.

The school has an After School Club which is open every day in term time from 3.30pm – 6.00pm and runs a Breakfast Club each morning from 8.00am – 8.45am.

The school has good working relationships with the local community including links with East Riding College and Bridlington Children's Centre. Transition links with pre-schools / nurseries and Secondary schools are excellent.

Currently there are 408 pupils on roll organised into 14 classes. There is a large team of support staff including 4 administrative staff and 17 lunchtime supervisors. The Leadership Team currently comprises Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher, School Business Manager, SENCO and EYFS & Key Stage I & Key Stage 2 Phase Leaders, English & Maths Coordinators.



The school serves a mixed catchment area and has an average to high proportion of pupils with Special Educational Needs. Pupil mobility is traditionally high as is typical of a seaside town but has reduced over the last few years. The school is committed to continued progress and high standards and is energetic about children's learning and development.

Bridlington is in the middle of a major Regeneration plan for the town centre and many initiatives have improved the town in recent years with many more planned.

The surrounding coastline and countryside of East Riding of Yorkshire provides many opportunities to enhance our children's learning.
