Glenmoor & Winton is a highly inclusive school that caters for the needs of all students. We ensure our most able students are stretched academically and students with special educational needs and disabilities are expertly supported allowing the Academies to ensure the best in everyone.

Glenmoor & Winton are unique schools due to the decision to co-locate the two Academies but remain separate schools through lessons being taught in a single sex environment. This has proved hugely successful with resources, staffing expertise and curriculum opportunities now being fully utilised for the benefit of all students at the Academies. Co-location has been seen by all stakeholders as offering the 'best of both' which I believe provides our students with the best possible chance of educational success.

2017 GCSE headline results are listed below for both Academies which reflect the outstanding progress the Academies have and continue to make.

Glenmoor Academy 85% achieved 4+ in both English & maths English 9 - 4: 89%, Maths 9 - 4: 86% & 2 Sciences A* - C: 76%

Winton Academy 70% achieved 4+ in both English & maths Mathematics 9 - 4: 83%, English 9 - 4: 75% & 2 Sciences A* - C: 70%
