JOB DESCRIPTION



The teacher will conform to the demands laid down by the 1980 Education Act and to the School Teachers Pay & Conditions Document. Whilst these conditions apply to all teachers nationally they are general and it is, therefore, helpful to relate them to the work of this particular School. At St. Francis of Assisi Primary School teachers are expected to uphold the Christian ethos of the School, to contribute to the further development of the Christian community and, by example, to help children live out the gospel values.

The candidate will be expected to manage all aspects of teaching and learning as set out in the Teachers Standards document

The candidate will be responsible for delivering high quality teaching and learning for the pupils who are assigned to them

The candidate will be expected to be an effective and reflective classroom teacher able to demonstrate and share good practice

The candidate will be expected to plan and prepare lessons with regard to individual need, and in line with school policy where applicable

The candidate will encourage pupils' motivation and enthusiasm, securing positive attitudes to learning and high standards of behaviour across the school

The candidate will monitor, evaluate, review pupils' progress, achievement and attainment regularly in accordance with school policy

The candidate will support leaders in the development and implementation of whole school initiatives

The candidate will provide excellent pastoral care to all pupils across the school

The candidate will ensure teaching is differentiated and ensure inclusivity

The candidate, together with their school based mentor, will openly discuss their own professional development needs and ensure that these needs are addressed through appropriate training.

The candidate will work collaboratively with all members of staff

The candidate will build and maintain excellent relationships with parents, and communicate with them on their pupils' learning and progress, drawing attention to special skills and talents as well as areas for development

The candidate will take part in the full life of the school by, attending assemblies, attending school events and actively taking part in special weeks organised by the school

The candidate will work closely and effectively with support staff across the school to ensure children reach their potential
