Background

International School Brunei was established in 1964, as a non-profit organisation with a Board of Directors to oversee the development of the school - a status that exists The Position to this day.

In 2015 the school moved to a brand new 22 acre site on the outskirts of Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of Brunei Darussalam. At the same time, 'The Residence' a state of the art Boarding House, was opened to cater for students aged 11 - 18. ISB also has a Primary School in Kuala Belait, Brunei. Our KB site is small and growing. Current plans are to move the school to a new site in 2019 to enable further growth and to meet the needs of the school's community.

The school offers Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum education from Pre-Kindy (2yrs) and an internationally adapted National Curriculum of England and Wales from Year 1 (4yrs old) to Year 9 (13yrs) followed by IGCSEs (15-16yrs) and the IB Diploma programme in the Pre-University section (16 -18yrs).

The school is non-selective, and currently has over 1200 students from over 42 different nationalities. Academic results outstanding, with IGCSE and IB Diploma

results consistently above the world average. The Application Process Students leave ISB to attend top universities all over the world.

ISB are looking to recruit a full time Lead Practitioner in Math and English. This would suit a Math or English specialist with a proven track record in raising standards and coaching colleagues. A secure knowledge of the Primary Science Curriculum is desirable. This is an ideal opportunity for an aspiring leader or a specialist leader of education (SLE). This is a new position for ISB and applicants need to be able to develop the role to meet the needs of the school and demonstrate working and leading using their own initiative.

The primary role of a Lead Practitioner is to model and lead the development of classroom expertise in Mathematics, English and Science. The Lead Practitioner will be an outstanding teacher. Whilst this role has no class commitment it is expected that the teacher team teaches, coaches colleagues and provides occasional cover.
