Thank you for considering Sandbach High School for the next stage of your career. We are looking for an excellent Religious Studies teacher (September 2018). This full-time position is for one year and has arisen due to a member of the RS team going on maternity leave.

The Religious Studies Department

The department has a strong identity and achieves highly at all key stages; last year 87.8% achieved A*-C at GCSE, with 56.1% achieving A*-C and 100% achieved A*-C at A2 level.

The RS department occupies a hub consisting of two specialist teaching rooms, a break out study room, a prayer room and an office. The department is well-resourced with one of the rooms being equipped with an interactive whiteboard, and both equipped with digital projectors. The department currently consists of three full time teachers of Religious Studies. This includes a Curriculum Leader and two teachers. All three members of the department have additional responsibilities: Curriculum Leader of Classical Civilisation, Teacher in Charge of Citizenship, PSHCE Co-ordinator and ASDAN Co-ordinator.

Curriculum

AT KS3 we broadly follow the local SACRE Non-Statutory framework, with some of our own in-house schemes of work. Staff are given the freedom to choose resources and plan lessons within the scheme so as to best address the needs of their classes.

At KS4 we follow the AQA Religious Studies Specification A, studying Christianity and Islam. The subject is an option at KS4; there is no compulsory examination.

At KS5 we offer Eduqas A level Religious Studies, with the three modules of Ethics, Philosophy of Religion and Islam split between the three teachers. The course is a two year course; students are not entered for AS exams.

Timetable

We run a 2 week timetable of 5, 1 hour lessons each day. At KS3, students have 2 lessons per fortnight. Students are taught by one teacher whenever possible, but it may be necessary to split classes between 2 staff.

KS4 students are taught in mixed ability classes, with 5 lessons per fortnight. KS5 students have 10 hours per fortnight, split between the three components.
