About Us

Panyathip is a well-established International School in Laos since its foundation in the Academic Year 2001-2002.



The School was initially registered as a Private

Education Institute by the Ministry of Education and Sports as a Bilingual School as it offered both an English as well as Lao programme, but has now gained the recognition as The British International School in Laos. Over the 16 years, we have grown from a small primary school with an enrolment of 60+ students to the current school enrolment of 1,000+ students, from the Kindergarten, Primary and Secondary, at the four campuses in Vientiane as well as one campus in Savannakhet.



Panyathip provides a sound academic programme but also exciting and creative teaching in a learning environment that brings out the best in our students. The School campuses house purpose-built facilities which include spacious classrooms and specialist rooms for Art, ICT, Music, Chinese and EAL as well as Libraries. Depending on the campus, sports facilities include all-weather football pitches, covered multi-purpose basketball court, and 25m swimming pool. Canteens serve the needs of the children during break and lunch times.

Our Curriculum

Panyathip Schools provide a safe and nurturing environment that encourages a child's physical, social, emotional and intellectual development. Our aims are for our students to discover and develop their full potential so that they can "Become the Best that You can Be".

It is our goal to deliver an academic programme to both Lao and International students so that when they have completed their education at Panyathip. They will be able to attend other schools or universities anywhere in the world.







Panyathip was the first school in Laos to be an accredited examination centre for Cambridge. The Primary School offers both an International as well as a Lao programme. The international Programme is for all primary class and the curriculum is developed under the framework of the English National Curriculum and the International Primary Curriculum (IPC). Secondary follow the IGCSE and beyond. An exciting new development in September 2018 will be the onsite delivery of a Foundation Course in partnership with Nottingham University.
