Humanities Faculty

The Humanities Faculty at Glebelands is a successful, forward thinking, high achieving faculty enjoying Key Stage 3 attainment levels which meet school targets and Key Stage 4 A* to C percentages which consistently out perform national averages.

In Key Stage 3 Humanities students are enthusiastic and well-motivated. Each department of Geography, History and Religious Education are fully implemented with schemes of work in place for all programmes of study. Attainment assessments are carried out progressively throughout Key Stage 3 along with half termly subject knowledge tests to monitor progress and skills.

At Key Stage 4 we follow different examination boards across each department Geography – OCR B, History – AQA and Religious Studies – AQA A (Christianity and Islam). A programme of assessment is used to monitor progress and develop skills throughout the courses. The Humanities Faculty strives to maintain excellent performance and has high expectations of students. Geography and History are popular choice for GCSE at Glebelands, with Religious Studies being compulsory at GCSE.

The Humanities Faculty is housed together along a single corridor with carpeted classrooms with south facing windows. Each department is well resourced. Each classroom has an interactive whiteboard and access to a wide range of textbooks at both Key Stage 3 and Key Stage 4. Schemes of work and assessments are in place for both key stages.

The Faculty currently contributes to whole school curriculum days (Focus Days) and organise extracurricular activities. These include a History trip to the Tower of London trip and a Geography fieldwork day, with focus on the individual student developing key skills and understanding.
