The majority of the teaching role for this position will be to develop a pioneering approach in the Innovation Centre, where KS2 classes are being introduced the advanced digital technologies of CAD/CAM, laser cutting, 3D printing, micro controllers etc., albeit through the continuation of the practical, problem solving approach of the subject. Knowledge, interest and experience in the latest developments in CAD/CAM and related technologies are therefore expected.
