BUSINESS/ICT FACULTY

The Business Studies/ICT Faculty comprises of 4 full time and 2 part time members of teaching staff including the Director of Faculty and Lead Teacher of IT and Computer Science.

The curriculum is structured into Key Stages. Within Key Stage 3, students are set according to ability. Key Stage 3 classes follow a customised scheme of work combining key ICT skills whilst covering a wide range of Computer Science theory and programming skills to meet the the National Curriculum and National Strategy.

Key Stage 4 begins in Year 9 and allows pupils to follow the most suitable pathway through ICT and Business Studies curriculums. All students study an ICT and Business Studies course. Computer Studies is an Option at GCSE.

At Key Stage 5, students have the choice to study a vocational Business Studies or IT qualification. The courses introduce them to a range of fundamental areas of the subject in preparation for further study in university, starting an apprenticeship or progressing to employment.

The Faculty is extremely well resourced. There are seven ICT rooms, two of which have recently had a complete remodelling and refurbishment, both are served by the support of a team of technicians. All staff have a school iPad and each room has a projector and desktop computer.

The Business and ICT Faculty is at a key turning point in developing an exciting and engaging curriculum to get the best results for our students. Continuous Professional Development is always encouraged from ITT students through to those with responsibilities within the Faculty.
