Job Title: Assistant Biology Laboratory Technician

Job Summary:

To assist in the provision of technical support and laboratory management within the Biology Department.

Key Responsibilities under supervision of Biology Technician:

- Assist with preparation of resources for practical lessons that meet both the health & safety standards and the requirements of the classes involved.
- Provide general assistance in the safe storage, transit and accessibility of resources, including helping to ensure that stock levels are maintained and future requirements are identified.
- Ensure a healthy, safe and productive work environment is maintained.

Core Activities:

- Preparation of resources for practical work including making up solutions, preparing materials and assembling apparatus.
- Obtaining materials by local purchase.
- Delivery of practical work to laboratories.
- Collection of, checking, and returning resources to stores.
- Maintaining resources.
- General cleaning of laboratory bench surfaces, fixed equipment and sinks.
- Clearing away after practical work, including appropriate disposal of materials.
- Cleaning used equipment.
- Assisting with routine maintenance/safety checks on laboratory equipment.
- Assisting with stock control.
- Keeping up-to-date with health and safety requirements, attending departmental meetings and training courses where required.

Other:

- Participate in training and other learning activities as required; and in the Probation and Professional Development Review process.
- Undertaking other similar duties and activities that fall within the band and role; and any
 other duties as may be reasonably required by the Head of Biology, the Bursar or the
 Head Master.

Salary and Benefits

Salary:

The salary for this role is £9,244 pe annum.

Working pattern:

22.5 hours per week, which will be arranged with the successful candidate on a term time only basis plus inset days, with one hour unpaid for lunch. Some flexibility of working hours may be required to assist with events.

Pension

Subject to meeting the qualifying conditions, support staff are eligible for the Aegon pension scheme. The school will contribute 8% if the staff contributes a minimum of 4% of their salary into the scheme. Please note that this is a defined-contribution pension scheme.

Healthcare

Staff may benefit from a heavily subsidised private healthcare plan run by PPP. To join, a part time member of staff has to contribute an amount per annum, determined by their contracted hours. The spouse and dependent children may also join the scheme at the prevailing corporate rate.

NOTE: Please note that Norwich School is located in the centre of Norwich with very limited parking.
