Main Responsibilities: Overall responsibility for leading and developing high quality

pedagogy: Modelling and sharing outstanding teaching and learning; The preparation and delivery of whole school and departmental CPD; developing a programme of support and guidance for all teachers

relative to their experience and expertise.

Leadership and Management:

- To develop high quality pedagogy throughout the department
- Promote the school's vision, culture and ethos of teaching and learning
- Create a culture of sharing best practice
- Lead and develop a coaching programme to support colleagues
