Overview

ICT is taught as a discrete subject to all years at Sandwell Academy. It is also a core component of all other subjects through the extensive use of interactive whiteboards and IT in every classroom.

Computing is also offered as an option subject at Key Stage 4 and at A level, and although these are new courses, demand is very high and initial results are very good.

Sandwell Academy has state of the art facilities with several large suites of Dell PCs running the standard Microsoft and Adobe packages together with numerous subject specialist packages.

Curriculum Structure

As of September 2017 ICT will be taught to all students in the following way:

- All year 7 and 8 follow a bespoke skills based programme in line with the Key Stage 3 strategy / the needs of Key Stage 4.
- Year 9 Options –students can chose Edexcel Certificate in Digital Applications or Computer Science OCR GCSE.
- Year 10 and 11- They continue with the Computer Science or ICT option.
- Sixth Form the majority of students will opt for either BTEC ICT or Computer Science at A level.
