
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01. About Academy Transformation Trust

As a not for profit trust, we work with our growing family of primary and secondary academies, and further education providers in the Midlands.




O2. The Dukeries Academy Information

03. Job Description

Inclusion Assistant, Secondary Academy

The purpose of this role is to ensure the effective running of the Academy Seclusion Room and to provide administrative support to the inclusion team in order to improve student behaviour and attendance.

Key responsibilities are:

- > To supervise students within the seclusion room for a proportion of the week, ensuring expectations for behaviour are met.
- > To ensure appropriate work is available for students to complete in the seclusion room including keeping resources held within the room up to date.
- > To ensure records of students' work and behaviour in the seclusion room are kept up to date.
- > To provide administrative support including updating records and completing referrals.
- > To provide additional support within the Academy inclusion unit as appropriate.
- > To follow up behaviour and attendance issues by liaising with other staff in the academy and contacting home as appropriate.
- > To use IT systems to provide data as required by members of the inclusion team.
- > To take an active role in supporting Academy systems and policies for inclusion and behaviour as appropriate.
- > The postholder will be expected to take an active part in appraising their own work against agreed priorities and targets in accordance with the Academy's management supervision guidelines.
- > The postholder will be expected to maintain confidentiality and observe data protection guidelines.
- > The postholder will be expected to undertake any necessary training associated with the duties of the post.
- > To undertake any other duties, which may reasonably be regarded as within the nature of the duties and responsibilities/grade of the post as defined.
- > To be responsible for own health and safety and that of pupils and staff, in accordance with the Academy Health and Safety policies to ensure wellbeing of all people on site
