PURPOSE OF THE JOB	To work as part of a team supervising pupils during the school lunch break, which includes attending to their welfare and domestic needs

## **EMPLOYMENT DUTIES**

## **MIDDAY SUPERVISOR**

- 1 Supervision of pupils immediately before, during and after the mid-day meal. This includes provision for children who bring sandwiches.
- 2 Supervision of hand washing and toileting by pupils as deemed necessary by the Headteacher.
- 3 Supervision of pupils entry and exit from the dining area, including supervision of pupils during any journey or walk to the dining room.
- 4 Supervision of pupils in the playground under the direction of the Lead Pastoral Practitioner.
- 5 Setting up and removal of playground equipment under the direction of the Lead Pastoral Practitioner.
- 6 Taking such steps as necessary when children are sick. Attending to their needs when in distress and reporting the situation to the relevant member of staff.
- 7 To arrange for emergency treatment when required, e.g. calling for a teacher if there has been an accident.
- 8 Vigilant in the playground in recognising potential dangers and approaching unauthorised personnel who enter the academy grounds.
- 9 Undertake an agreed programme of training.
- 10 To carry out other duties relating to lunchtime supervision as requested by the Headteacher, Deputy Head or Senior Leadership Team.
- The above duties are not exhaustive and the post holder may be required to undertake tasks, roles and responsibilities as may be reasonably assigned to them by the Senior Leadership Team.
- This job description will be kept under review and may be amended via consultation with the individual and/or Senior Leadership Team as required. Trade union representation will be welcomed in any such discussions.
