Welcome from the Chief Executive

Thank you for considering our Principal vacancy at Eden Girls' School, Coventry.

I would like to share with you a little of where we are in the school's journey in the hope that it will stir you into applying for the post and will inspire in you a realisation of how you might take this already outstanding school onto even greater successes and accolades on behalf of our students and their parents.

"Leaders and governors have created an environment where pupils and teachers believe that anything is possible" (Ofsted July 2017)

Ofsted's findings in the school's first inspection in July 2017 captured some of the key achievements of Eden Girls' School, Coventry in the culmination of its first three years. Inspectors recognised that:

"Leaders have worked tirelessly to create a highly aspirational culture of academic performance, moral development and civic duty."

"Staff are highly supportive of leaders and morale is high because staff see the positive impact of their work. As one member of staff commented: 1 am proud to work for a school that goes above and beyond for the pupils. We are not doing a "job". We are building the future; this is a responsibility we all take very seriously.' This comment is representative of many others that staff gave in Ofsted's online survey."

Having led the school through a number of its early key milestones including the move into a state of the art new build, the school's first Ofsted inspection, the school's first GCSE results and full and oversubscribed year groups from 7 – 11, the current Principal is moving back to the Trust's Central team to lead on the implementation of our evidence-based teaching strategy thus supporting the next phase of our growth.

Since Eden Girls' School, Coventry opened in 2014 the TET family of schools has grown rapidly from seven to over twenty come September 2018. The increase the number of its schools arises from the Government's confidence in its provision, due in no small part to the excellent, personalised support provided by the Trust to all its schools:

"The Trust has given the school effective support to set up all of its management systems since it opened. These systems, such as support for senior leaders, regular training, briefings and support with teaching and learning, mean that leaders have focused closely on pupils' progress and development." 
