Thank you for showing an interest in teaching History at Christ's College. As a small department of three teachers, we are a very supportive team. The History department is well respected by staff and students and History is consistently one of the most popular subjects for GCSE and A Level.

At GCSE, we teach the Edexcel 9-1 specification. Our chosen topics are Early Elizabethan England, American West, Medicine Through Time and Weimar and Nazi Germany. If any of these topics are new to you, you will benefit from a multi-resourceful shared area and regular departmental meetings where you can be supported in this.

At A Level, we currently teach the OCR History A specification. This consists of Churchill and Britain 1930-1997, Crusades and Crusader States, Civil Rights in the USA 1865-1992 and a coursework option. There is a possibility of A Level teaching for the right candidate, although this isn't a requirement as part of this role.

There are plenty of opportunities to be involved in extra-curricular activities as part of the History department and Humanities faculty. Each year we run parliamentary style debates in KS3, we run a scheme for the most able students called 'Future Leaders' and we have a variety of trips in KS3, KS4 and KS5.
