Faculty Information

Range High School is at an exciting stage in its development having been judged 'Outstanding' in five consecutive Ofsted reports, most recently in May 2013, and having been designated as a Teaching School since September 2015. It is located in Formby in a fine residential area offering good commuter links. This is a flourishing, and innovative school with an excellent reputation for its commitment to high standards and to the care of its students as individuals.

Examination results at KS3, GCSE and Advanced level are exceptionally good. The Mathematics Faculty

The faculty consists of eleven specialist teachers of Mathematics who work together, supported by one Higher Level Teaching Assistant, as a committed, innovative team to secure high levels of pupil progress in all key stages.

Eight mainstream specialist rooms are used for the teaching of the subject and all rooms are equipped with an interactive whiteboard.

Throughout KS3 the pupils are set according to ability with one small special needs group in each year. The Oxford Maths Links scheme is used together with a wide variety of other teaching and learning resources to ensure that the national curriculum is fully implemented in all year groups.

At KS4, Years 10 and 11 are set according to ability on a full year basis. Students follow the new AQA GCSE specification.

Uptake for A level Mathematics is high. AQA Advanced level courses are offered in both Mathematics and Further Mathematics including modules in Pure, Mechanics, Statistics and Discrete.
