Employment Duties

Main responsibilities of the job

Curriculum:

- Implement the National Curriculum
- Contribute to discussion about priorities
 - Assist in the review, construction and resourcing of the curriculum taking the lead in this for teaching*

- Help to draw up departmental homework and coursework policies within the school guidelines
- Help to evaluate schemes of work to ensure that they focus on consistent and effective teaching and learning
- Help to analyse and interpret data on pupils' attainment in the subject
- Help to agree targets for raising attainment within the context of whole-school targets

Staff:

- Help to review with teachers their assessments of progress for classes, identified groups and individuals
- Review teachers' planning
- Observe teaching and feed back to colleagues
- Help to facilitate improvement in teaching
- Monitor and advise on quality of teachers' assessment for learning
- Help to identify and provide for staff training and development needs
- Undertake designated Performance Management Reviews and help staff within the department to set development targets and to achieve them
- Help to promote teamwork and motivate staff, including FLAs, to ensure effective working relations
- Participate in the interview process for teaching posts when required and help to provide effective induction for new staff (including FLAs and NQTs) in line with school procedures

Pupils:
