Thank you for your interest in this full-time position. We are looking to appoint a Head of Year from September 2018. This is an exciting career development opportunity for an ambitious teacher with aspirations for a senior leadership position in the future.

Following the semi-retirement of the current post-holder, after 27 years leading six year groups, we are looking to appoint an enthusiastic and dedicated professional to this crucial role in the school. Applicants must be exemplary tutors and outstanding practitioners who are passionate about working with young people and helping them develop into happy, confident and successful young adults.

The person appointed will join a very strong and committed Care & Guidance team. S/he will be responsible for a year group of approximately 280 pupils and for the leadership and management of a team of 10 tutors, including a deputy head of year. Year Heads remain with their year group through Years 7 to 11 and the person appointed will initially have responsibility for Year 7 from September 2018.

The high standards of care, guidance and academic monitoring of pupils achieved by the pastoral team underpin Sheldon's ethos. The successful candidate will be expected to build on these firm foundations and develop the role still further.

The intention is that the teaching commitment will be determined after the appointment, according to subject specialism.
