

Outstanding Opportunities

We believe every child should have the opportunity to create, compose and perform, as well as to visit and participate in extraordinary work.

As a David Ross Education Trust school, we provide an array of valuable enrichment opportunities that help our students discover their talents, and are amongst the very best that can be found in both the state and independent education sectors.

With the support of inspirational partner organisations and the benefactors of our scholarship programmes, our students have trained with Olympians, been inspired by artists and visited parts of the world they may never have imagined possible.

Personal development

Supporting our students to become confident, well-rounded young people is a hallmark of a Trust education.

Across the Trust we have embedded leadership programmes and extensive Outward Bound experiences for our primary and secondary school students.

These range from ecological conservation projects on the Caribbean islands of St Vincent and the Grenadines, to a three-week residential in the Canadian wilderness, as well as many other UK-based opportunities.

Our academies also encourage students to become critical thinkers and form strong opinions about topical issues. Across every school community we operate Student Councils, which encourage students to help set the expectations and behaviour standards that their peers follow.

From participating in The Economist's Burnet News Club to taking part in debating competitions, our students are actively aware of the world around them and the role they have to play in society.

Lodge Park Academy is proud to have a growing Combined Cadet Force unit, encouraging young people to see the value of self-discipline and self-respect.

Through the generous support of benefactors, including Mr Crispin Odey and the Stuart Horne Bursary, our scholarship programmes also enable the Trust to support every child to develop their talents, wherever they may lie.



The Arts

Creativity and inspiration are at the heart of our curriculum. Our students have access to activities such as opera and ballet performances, musical competitions, artist masterclasses and meetings with poets and authors.

Every child will have the chance to make their mark through Trust-wide art competitions, allowing imaginative students to submit entries across a number of different categories such as art, design, photography and short stories.

Our school has enjoyed visits from internationally acclaimed British artists including Marc Quinn, David Dawson and Jonathan Yeo as well as trips to the Saatchi Gallery, Tate Britain Gallery and Jonathan Yeo's London studio.

Music

Music is an integral part of life at Lodge Park Academy. The principles of high-quality music-making: listening, adapting, exploring, persevering, problem-solving, thinking laterally and performing without fear, are seen in every student and every teacher.

From working alongside acclaimed musicians, to performing at prestigious David Ross Education Trust music events, every student is provided with outstanding platforms to build their confidence and grow their musical talents.

The Trust provides incredible pathways for our talented musicians to participate and excel in aspirational music-making. Key partnerships with renowned organisations have provided outstanding opportunities for our students to help inspire and raise aspiration.

Sport

- Promotes the school's values, such as caring for each other, respecting their learning environment and trying their best.
- Follows the school's expectations, systems and routines.

Pastoral Support


