THE DEPARTMENT

This department is presently staffed by two full-time members of staff. The department itself is well resourced and accommodated in dedicated rooms that have the benefit of full ICT facilities.

The AQA Business Studies specifications for both GCSE and A-level are followed and the subject remains a popular option (43 students in the Fourth Year, 44 in the Fifth Year; 33 in the Sixth Form).

The department has achieved very good results in recent years and is determined to maintain this high level of attainment (92% A* - C at GCSE; 36% A*/A, 100% A* - C at A-level).

Economics is introduced in the Sixth Form and the Edexcel A Level specification is followed.
