They will be able to teach across all year groups, up to and including A Level. - Knowledgeable of successful and innovative teaching and the latest curriculum developments in Drama.

The department currently consists of the Director of Drama, a Teacher of Drama, and a full time Theatre Technician. All pupils take Drama for one period a week in Year 7 and Year 8. In Year 9 pupils opt for three creative subjects and the majority choose to continue Drama. The subject is popular at both GCSE and A Level.

GCSE and A level performances are well attended, as are major school productions, House Drama and plays produced by different year groups. Recent productions include 'The 39 Steps', 'Romeo and Juliet', 'School of Rock' and 'Joseph and the Amazing Technicolour Dreamcoat'.

Pupils enjoy a variety of extra-curricular Drama activities. The Department currently has use of the School Hall and the Beardwood Theatre as well as a Drama Studio, a rehearsal room and a dedicated office space. The Theatre Technician assists with lighting, sound and the management of costumes and props. We organise theatre trips to London's West End for all year groups and enjoy a wide variety of visiting theatre companies. LAMDA is an extremely popular extra-curricular choice for our pupils and we currently have two LAMDA teachers offering a variety of different skills.

Teachers appointed to posts are expected to maintain high professional standards and contribute significantly to the extra-curricular life of the school. For Drama teachers in particular, this will take the form of some after school rehearsals and a weekend rehearsal in the week before a production.
