Classroom teaching responsibilities.

- Support the personal development and wellbeing of students and where welfare concerns are identified, to seek support from the School Counsellor and Programme Heads.

- Openly exchange ideas, expertise, resources and tools with colleagues and within the subject areas to improve teaching within the school.
- Offer support, information and guidance to new teachers as they settle in to their roles, the school and a new country.
