For example: those with a low skill base, hearing or visual impairment, the very able Working with staff in other departments to agree schemes of work so that the content of courses is complementary and provides students with a broader understanding of DT and its links with other fields of study Ensuring that the statutory requirements of the National Curriculum are met Setting targets for pupil achievement Evaluating the design and delivery of the DT curriculum; continuously striving to improve all aspects Monitoring and evaluating progress towards meeting pupil achievement targets in own classes and those aspects of the DT curriculum for which s/he is responsible Ensuring that there is an effective assessment, recording and reporting system of student progress Regularly use of appropriate ICT initiatives to improve learning for pupils and staff Providing reports to the Key Stage Co-ordinator or Subject Leader regarding curriculum matters in defined areas Contributing to the development of initiatives to outreach to the community Assisting the Key Stage Co-ordinator and/or Subject Leader to create and implement ways of actively involving parents in the learning process Instigating, developing and maintaining links with relevant companies so as to enrich the learning experience of both the School Community and the Commercial partners Supporting the facilitation of a broad range of activities involving staff, students and the wider community so as to deepen and broaden learners' experience in DT issues Maintaining a high quality level of visual display within the classroom
