General Information

Francis Holland School Sloane Square is an independent selective school for about 530 girls aged 4 to 18 (GSA and Society of Heads). There are 164 Juniors and 356 Seniors, including 72 in the Sixth Form. The School is located on a spacious site in a quiet area of SW1, very close to Sloane Square. The staffing ratio is generous and the School has its own attractive salary scale. Interest free travel loans are available and assistance with removal expenses is also offered for new appointments.

Pupils come from all parts of the London area with many of the Junior School pupils choosing to stay for the Senior School. Each member of staff is involved in the pastoral life of the School, normally as a Form Tutor, the Junior School having one form throughout and Years 7 to 11 having

two or three forms per year. The Sixth Form girls are placed in tutor groups of about 8 girls. A very wide range of co-curricular opportunities are offered to the pupils, and all staff contribute to this vibrant dimension of the School.

Academic standards are high throughout the School and on leaving school, after A Levels, girls all proceed to higher education courses, sometimes after a gap year.

Science Department Information

The Science Department is housed in a separate science block with five up-to-date, spacious laboratories. Each laboratory is equipped with a networked PC, projector, and sound system and all have interactive whiteboards. There are eight science teachers and two experienced technicians. All members of the department are enthusiastic in their support of the aims of the department. All staff contribute extensively to the continual development of resources and sharing of good classroom practice.

We follow the AQA A Level specification at KS5, Edexcel IGCSE specification at KS4 and offer both the Triple Science and Double Award IGCSE Science courses.

The Department has a proud record of excellent performance at GCSE and A level.
