ENTRY REQUIREMENTS & PATHWAYS

LEVEL 3

ACADEMIC ONLY

- Minimum of five 4+ grades or A*-C in at least 4 different GCSE subjects, including English & Maths.
- A grade 5 is required for any A-Level option.
- English and Maths grades to indicate ability for options where a student hasn't taken a GCSE.

ACADEMIC/VOCATIONAL MIX

- Students must meet the A Level requirements for any A Level option.
- Minimum of five 4+ grades or A*-C in 4 different subjects for the BTECs.
- Good behaviour & attendance record.
- GCSE Maths & English must be retaken if not at a grade 4 or above.

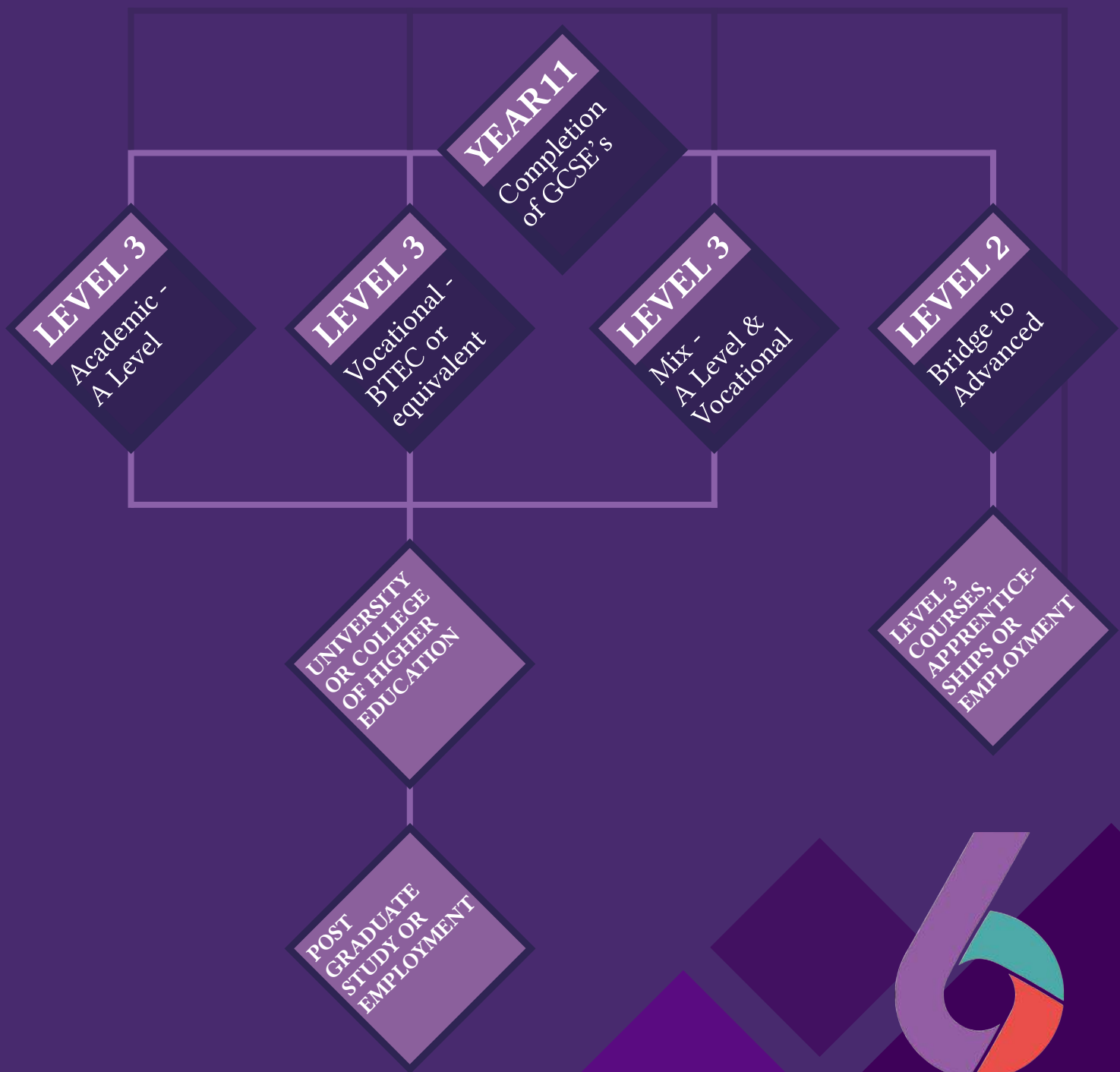
VOCATIONAL ONLY

- Minimum of five 4+ grades or A*-C in 4 different subjects.
- Good behaviour & attendance record.
- GCSE Maths & English must be retaken if not at a grade C or above.

LEVEL 2

- If you are unable to access our Level 3 courses with your results, you may be able to access our Level 2 'Bridge to Advanced'.
- A guidance interview will take place to assess your suitability for the courses.

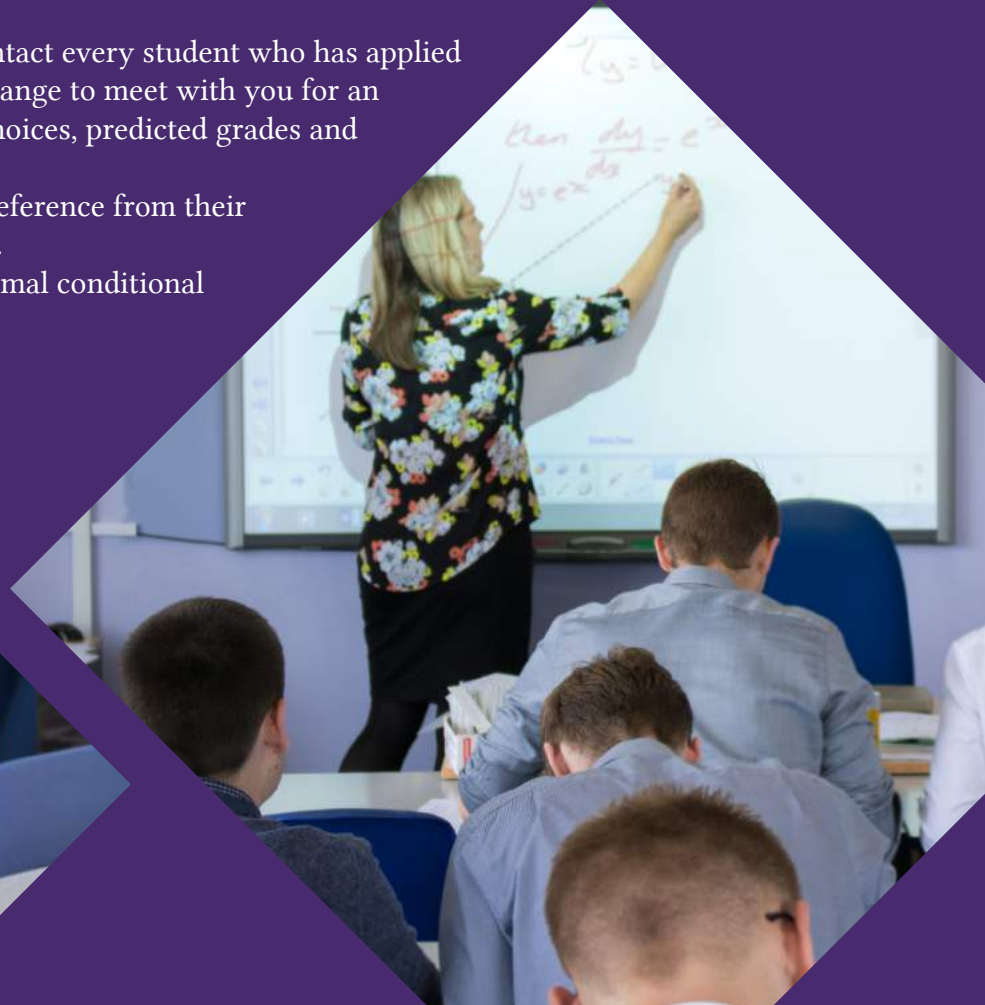
APPLICATION

HOW DO I APPLY TO THE SIXTH FORM?

1. Look at the 'Course Information Booklet' for details of courses available and their entry requirements.
2. Choose the courses that suit your needs and fill in an initial application form. If you have any queries, speak to a member of the Sixth Form team or subject teacher. There is also an online application form.
3. Submit your initial application by the final week of the Autumn term.

WHAT HAPPENS NEXT?

- A member of the Sixth Form team will contact every student who has applied for Sixth Form @ South Wirral, and will arrange to meet with you for an informal interview. Here you will discuss choices, predicted grades and career aspirations.
- External applicants must bring a written reference from their current school, along with predicted grades.
- If successful, you can hope to receive a formal conditional offer in the post.
