The British International School Budapest is a caring, multicultural community where the development of the intellect is complemented by the pursuit of personal and interpersonal growth.


We aspire to excellence. We pursue deep learning in all that we do, through disciplined inquiry, reflection and perseverance.

The British International School Budapest seeks enthusiastic, flexible, committed teachers to join our school from August 2019. We are a closeknit, supportive team of professionals, committed to the education, well-being and growth of our international community.

Our students aged 3-18 comprise **over 70 nationalities** and enjoy a **British-style international education** through the medium of English. Starting in a spacious Early Years Centre, the National Curriculum for England frames the education provision through to the end of Key Stage 4, when students take GCSEs and IGCSEs before embarking on the IB Diploma Programme in our Sixth Form.

Recent building developments allow us to expand steadily towards our capacity of just over 1000 students over the next 2-3 years.

We are an inclusive school embracing the diversity of our community. We are ambitious for our students who progress to top universities around the world.



Our location and facilities

Located beside a golf course in the leafy 3rd District of Budapest, a short distance from the Danube and the centre of the city, our school campus is modern and very well resourced. Primary students benefit from one-to-one iPads and secondary students bring their own devices. Computer labs, coding rooms, an art & innovation studio and music practice rooms are equipped with first class facilities, enabling our students to take advantage of our collaboration with MIT and The Juilliard School. A recently completed building project includes additional specialist facilities for science, computing, music and sports.

Budapest is a modern, cosmopolitan city, steeped in history and within easy reach of beautiful countryside. Conde Nast Traveler regularly places Budapest as one of the world's best cities to live in. Budapest is also one of the world's most affordable cities, located in the heart of Europe, within easy reach of the best of central, eastern and western Europe. Public transport, the arts and culture, shopping, dining and outdoor activity are incomparable. Several of our teachers have chosen to settle here, while others move on to international careers within Nord Anglia Education and beyond.

Our vision

We are ambitious for our students and their families, our staff and our school. Our strategic plan sets out five key areas for growth and development over the coming years. These areas are:

Identity - a caring multicultural community

Our mission statement is our compass and through it we seek to define and reinforce our reputation as the premium British international school in Budapest. The moral imperatives of our mission drive our decisions and our actions. We engage students in interrogating the mission and link our Code of Conduct and our rewards system clearly to our mission.

Learning - working together to do what works

Learning is the focus for all that we do. We cannot leave this to chance or rely exclusively on the "folk wisdom" of teaching. We continuously and deliberately raise the standards of learning, through developing productive student-teacher relationships, the most effective pedagogy and the best and most incisive assessment practices. Specifically, we use baseline diagnosis through GL Assessment's bank of tests, and combine this with close tracking and effective intervention. We focus on the best of empirically verified pedagogy as validated by the latest cognitive neuroscience and make learning and teaching the focus of all professional development, specifically in the areas of EAL, effective feedback, collaborative learning, self-regulation and metacognitive strategies.

Language - embracing and developing our linguistic strengths

Situated at the heart of Europe, we are blessed with a huge range of languages in our community and a large number of our students achieve a Bilingual Diploma of the International Baccalaureate Our medium of instruction is English and therefore we focus on an evolving programme of EAL support and intensive induction.

Technologies - using technology to learn and learning to use technologies

iPads are used throughout the Primary School and students in Secondary bring their own laptops. All students and staff have free access to Office 365, unlimited online storage and the opportunity to download the full Office suite to up to 5 devices each. We are part of a collaboration with Massachusetts Institute of Technology (MIT) and we develop our students' engagement with Science, Technology, Engineering, Art and Mathematics (STEAM) though our innovative curricula and visits to MIT in Boston.

Infrastructure - building the foundations for future excellence

We have recently expanded our classroom spaces by 50% and opened a new sports facility in September 2017. We will grow in student numbers over the coming years, recruit additional staff and develop our leadership structures. We will develop our policies and practices, our timetabling and scheduling, our professional development and performance management systems. We will make full use of our MIS (iSAMS), our HR system (Success Factors), our IB Diploma management system (ManageBac) and others.
