Vision and Values

At Oakwood we encourage everyone to 'be the best that they can be' within a safe environment where education can prepare all children to be ready for life.

Oakwood Primary Academy will:

- Nurture all children in a safe and stimulating environment
- Provide for them a style of education that inspires the will to learn
- Prepare them for making wise choices throughout their lives
- Enable them to face their lives with courage and compassion

We believe that:

- Each human being is special, gifted, unique.
- We should value others for what they are not just for what they do.
- We should balance high self-esteem with respect for others.
- Good relationships are fundamental for both our own individual good and for the good of the community as a whole.

We will provide:

- Structured learning that provides children with a wide range of skills.
- A wide-ranging rich curriculum.
- Frequent opportunities for all children to express themselves creatively.
- Encouragement to communicate well and listen to others.

We will enable all children to:

- Value the beauty of the natural world.
- To wonder at the mystery of life and its possible origins.
- To feel the need to distinguish between good and bad, right and wrong.
- To see how they can promote their own health and well-being.
- To be ready for their wider role as citizens

At Oakwood we have taken some of the core <u>Co-op values</u> to devise a value based system called 'ROOTS'. The children learn about Responsibility, Openness, Optimism, how to be Trustworthy and the importance of Solidarity. This is done through explicit teaching of the language of values, assemblies that teach how to live the values and reward systems that celebrate children who show strong ROOTS.

About Oakwood Primary Academy

Oakwood Primary Academy is a larger than average two - form entry school situated in the Gipton area of inner city Leeds. We currently have more than 470 children on roll. Within this our families have more than 40 different home languages.

Oakwood Primary Academy is committed to promoting community cohesion within a multi-cultural and mobile community. Our curriculum and the consistent approach to behaviour and attitudes results in a welcoming positive climate, where children are welcomed whatever their background and educational history and quickly become part of the school community. Children have a very positive attitude to school and to learning. Our most recent inspection (June 2015) clearly recognises the strengths in our support for children and families.

Progress throughout the key stages is accelerating and future attainment outcomes look set to improve. Progress measures for end of Key Stage 2 in 2018 continue to be well above the floor standard and look to be building on the strengths that are clearly emerging in the 2016 and 2017 outcomes.

The team at Oakwood are determined to build on the positive outcome of our 2015 inspection. There is a strong distributed leadership team at Oakwood with experienced senior and middle leaders. Staff development is embedded in all school approaches, with a culture of mentoring, support and challenge.

Governors provide strong leadership to the school supported by the wider trust and are fully involved in the strategic planning and development of the school.

At Oakwood, there is a strong emphasis on developing spiritual, moral, social and cultural education. Established extended services provision and the use of dedicated sports coaches within the curriculum and at break, lunchtimes and after school promotes physical development and well-being throughout the school.

Oakwood is very proud to have supported the opening of Nightingale Primary Academy. Nightingale opened in September 2014 and the leadership team at Oakwood were integral to the growth of the school right up to its first inspection in June 2017. Oakwood and its team gained tremendous experience during this period. We want the successful candidate to join our outward facing team and be part of moving not only Oakwood onwards and upwards, but to support the wider Trust schools to prosper.
