International School Brunei



Background

International School Brunei was established in 1964, as a non-profit organisation with a Board of Directors to oversee the development of the school - a status that exists to this day.

In 2015 the school moved to a brand new 22 acre site on the outskirts of Bandar Seri Begawan, the capital of Brunei Darussalam. At the same time, 'The Residence' a state of the art Boarding House, was opened to cater for students aged 11 - 18. ISB also has a Primary School in Kuala Belait, Brunei. Our KB site is small and growing. Current plans are to move the school to a new site in 2019 to enable further growth and to meet the needs of the school's community.

The school offers Early Years Foundation Stage Curriculum education from Pre-Kindy (2yrs) and an internationally adapted National Curriculum of England and Wales from Year 1 (4yrs old) to Year 9 (13yrs) followed by IGCSEs (15-16yrs) and the IB Diploma programme in the Pre-University section (16 - 18yrs).

The school is non-selective, and currently has over 1200 students from over 42 different nationalities. Academic results are outstanding, with IGCSE and IB Diploma

results consistently above the world average. Students leave ISB to attend top universities all over the world.

The Position

International School Brunei requires an experienced teacher to join the successful PE team. The ideal candidate will join a dynamic department focussed on the highest possible standards of teaching and learning. The post includes responsibility for our whole school Extra Curricular Activity (ECA) programme.

Core PE is a fundamental part of the ISB learning experience with students from reception onward receiving two hours of PE and swimming per week. There are also a wide range of extra-curricular activities and clubs for students to take part in, including participation in inter-house competitions; local leagues and cups; and the international FOBISIA games.

As the Head of ECAs the successful candidate will have strategic and operational oversight for the programme and will be responsible for ensuring continued quality and success. All staff are expected to offer an ECA activity at least once per week. It is large in scope, scale and variety – encompassing sports, cultural, creative, community service and academic enrichment opportunities.

The Application Process

Interested candidates are asked to submit the following documents:

- On line application form and covering letter including a passport sized photograph.
- The names and contact details (including a telephone number) for three professional referees, one of whom must be your current Headteacher/Principal.

Longlisted applicants will be contacted within two weeks of the stated closing date with Skype interviews scheduled as soon as possible thereafter. If you have not heard from us by this time, you should assume that your application has been unsuccessful on this occasion.

Successful candidates are offered an initial two year contract, with the option to renew based on performance.
