- You'll be responsible for maintaining equipment and ensuring that it is returned and ready for the next booking.
- When we have a plan to roll out any new technologies including our radio studios, you'll be part of the team that organises this and makes sure everything works as it should.
- You'll work with the Broadcast Engineering teams to make sure that the broadcast technology systems are looked after properly so that they are "always on"

- You'll have brilliant organisational skills so you can juggle lots of different priorities
- You'll possess the ability to stay calm and keep other people calm when the pressure is on
- You'll have amazing problem solving-skills and the desire to use technology to challenge the status quo of how we do things

- You'll have an excellent knowledge of IT and broadcast technology stuff.
