ABOUT US

Bromsgrove School Mission Hills (BMH) is a co-educational, bilingual (English and Mandarin) through-train day school for students in Kindergarten to University entrance.

Our goal is to serve a growing number of Chinese nationals and expatriates in the Shenzhen region who have an interest in having their children attend a pre-eminent

dual language international school.

Our campus is located on the property owned by Mission Hills and immediately adjacent to the Mission Hills resort in Shenzhen, China. By car, it is only 30 minutes from Shenzhen City Centre.

The Prep School follows the framework of the National Curriculum in England, with which content streams found in the Chinese Primary School curriculum are integrated.

We draw much of our pedagogical approach from the International Baccalaureate's Primary Years Programme and refer to Canadian curricula for specific curriculum areas including enhancement of Information and computer technology teaching and learning.

The programme is standards-based and will provide children with a broad range of knowledge, skills and attitudes.

WORKING AND PROFESSIONAL DEVELOPMENT

At BMH we aim to facilitate a culture of professional growth.
