



MFL Department

There are currently 5 members of staff in the department with one Subject Leader for MFL. All teachers currently teach both French and Spanish to KS3 and can teach one language to KS5. We also provide the primary French teaching in our feeder schools from Year 3-6.

KS3

Key Stage 3 provision is currently 5 x 1 hour lessons per 2-week cycle in Years 7 and 8. Pupils study either French or Spanish in mixed-ability groups. Class sizes are 25-32 pupils. We use the Studio and Viva textbooks and 'activelearn' online resources.

KS4

French and Spanish GCSE is taught in mixed-ability groups with class sizes of 15-20. Pupils start the GCSE course in Year 9 and have 5 x 1 hour lessons per 2-week cycle. We follow the AQA Syllabus for GCSE and use the Studio and Viva textbooks and 'activelearn' online resources.

KS5

Key Stage 5 provision is currently 9 x 1 hour lessons per 2-week cycle. The department offers A level French, following the AQA syllabus. We use the OUP textbook and 'kerboodle' online resources
