St Ambrose College is part of the Edmund Rice Network of schools, which extends around the globe; we have a special link with St Ambrose Academy in Sierra Leone. Ten upper sixth form students have recently returned from Freetown. Our goal to support the digging of a borehole to provide water for the Academy will soon be achieved. The College is also raising funds to support two staff members at Easter to visit the Edmund Rice mission in Zambia.

The opportunity has arisen to lead a college, which is consistently one of the top Catholic schools in the country. In August 2017, we gained the best results in the history of the College with 86.3% of pupils achieving 5A\*- B including English and Mathematics at GCSE and 74.9% of pupils achieved A\*- B and

47.7% A\*- A at A2. The College has an enviable Progress 8 score of +0.41, and Attainment 8 score of 68.8 points. Our A level Progress score is +0.12 with an average result of 38.43 points (B).

The sports facilities are the envy of most schools, with badminton, basketball, football, swimming, tennis, hockey, indoor rowing, rugby, athletics, cricket, softball, handball, volleyball, table tennis and water polo are part of our curriculum. St Ambrose has a strong sporting history, providing rugby internationals and with a succession of National and regional honours in rugby, swimming, athletics, water polo and indoor rowing.
