Key responsibilities are:

- To work as a Specialist Lead Practitioner in Science in academies to secure good and outstanding outcomes
- To provide support proportionate to need to ensure value for money to develop good and outstanding teaching within Science, acting as a coach when needed.
- To ensure the Science curriculum is fit for purpose and enables pupils to experience high quality experiences within the geographical cluster
- To be outcome driven to secure outstanding outcomes
- To take a strategic lead in their area of specialism within the local geographical cluster and link with your equivalent in the West Region.
- To support and challenge subject leads to ensure the appropriate strategy for raising achievement in their academies and within the cluster as a whole
- To work with key pupils to raise attainment and improve progress in academies
- To ensure assessment practice is robust and accurate
- To support the moderation of teacher assessments
- To facilitate collaborative working across the cluster through forums with an emphasis on sharing best practice
