The Geography Department at Teign School is an enthusiastic, successful department.

At Key Stage 3 Geography is taught to Years 7 and 8 in mixed ability form groups. Each pupil at Key Stage 3 receives 3 x 60 minute lessons over two weeks. During Key Stage 3 each pupil will expect to take part in fieldwork during each year 7 and 8.

At Key Stage 4 Geography is a very popular subject with approximately four groups in Years 9, 10 and 11. The results are also excellent and Geography regularly has amongst the highest 'levels of progress' data in the school. The students again take part in fieldwork including a residential visit to the Lake District or Paris.

At Key Stage 5 Geography is again a popular subject with regularly large numbers of Post-16 Geographer students. The results are again outstanding and many students continue to study Geography related courses at University.
