

Teacher of English

The English department is housed in four classrooms, each fitted with their own Interactive whiteboard and projector. All teachers have access to ICT.

Staffing includes a full time Curriculum Leader of English with an Assistant Principal who is a Lead Teacher for English, with an additional 2 teachers. This is an exciting time for the academy, especially in English. We are leading the school in our combined approach to the new GCSE 9-1 grading system and have implemented an exciting new KS3 curriculum that builds student skills towards GCSE right from the first term of year 7.

THE CURRICULUM

All students are taught in sets. This allows teaching to be consistently directed at the appropriate level. Students on the Special Educational Needs register receive additional help from teaching assistants in the classroom.

In Year 7 students study a combined curriculum of English and Ethics across 5 lessons a week. In year 9 students have 5 lessons a week and then 4 lessons a week in years 10 and 11. We are currently teaching the AQA GCSE English Language and Literature specifications.

BEYOND THE CURRICULUM

Outside of lessons, we have strong links with primary schools through our summer reading challenges for year 6 students. This project gives students the opportunity to complete research projects on texts from their year 7 curriculum over the summer holidays. We have been majorly successful in promoting creative writing across the school.
