## **Educational Leadership**

Demonstrated qualifications, experience, professional learning and skills to develop, support and implement high quality, contemporary evidence-based practices and learning programs that are in line with national, state and Brisbane Catholic Education requirements.

Demonstrated ability to apply contemporary learning and teaching research and analysis of student learning to classroom practice and to grow student achievement
