Science is taught in a large, modern block that is both attractive and well-resourced. There is a team of three lab technicians, a horticultural area and even a small school zoo, in which can be found mongooses, macaws, fruit bats and much more besides.

The teacher of science will be expected to become involved with the teaching of both A Level and GCSE classes.

In 2017, those students who completed the Biology A Level achieved 93% A*- C grades with over half gaining an A* or A, the Chemistry A Level 100% A*- C and 70% A*- A and Physics 79% A*- B.

GCSE Biology students achieved 100% A*-C, GCSE Chemistry 90% A*- C and Physics 100% A*-C.

We teach science because we would like to spread the habit of independent thought which is based on evidence, and which is therefore open to question and to test - "This is to be distinguished from the ape-like habit of mere imitation", as Charles Darwin said.

Our aim is that all Science students should be capable, independent thinkers and students possessing a life-long love of science and the process of scientific inquiry and thought.
