The position is for a full-time French Teacher to teach to our French native pupils. We are seeking to appoint a teacher who is:

- Fluent communicator in written and spoken French
- Dynamic, self-motivated and flexible
- Qualified teacher and has undergone appropriate training
- High expectation of pupils' attainment, progress and behaviour
- Enjoys a good rapport with children
- Works effectively as part of a team, building positive relationships with colleagues
- Plans effectively and is sensitive to the learning needs of pupils of different abilities
- Regularly assesses pupils' work formally and informally, using Assessment for Learning strategies
- Has good administration skills
- Approachable and confident when corresponding with the parents of pupils
- Committed to participation in the wider life of the school
