Duties of the Post

The role of Teacher of French will cover the following areas:

Leadership

- Presenting a positive role model within the classroom and around the school
- Promoting a desire to learn for all students in his/her charge
- > Establishing a conducive learning environment within all his/her classes

Management

- Ensuring that school procedures are adhered to with particular regard classroom management
- Managing his/her time effectively to ensure that all internal and external deadlines are met

Teaching and Learning

- > Ensure that sufficient opportunities are given within teaching groups to expand students' understanding and learning of the subject
- Ensuring sufficient preparation with recorded lesson plans, which conform to the scheme of work of the subject
- > Conforming to the school's assessment policies and procedures
- Regular marking with constructive feedback to progress student learning

Monitoring

- Comply with the school's Monitoring, Evaluation and Review Policy
- Monitor student progress and liaise with the Subject Leader

Training and Development

> To continue to follow an agreed programme of personal professional development

- > Teach up to 85% of the school week in French and any other subject in which the postholder is qualified
