Our children and young people can access Severndale Specialist Academy from Reception through to Sixth Form and have a range of learning difficulties, physical and mobility difficulties and some pupils who require personal care. A number of our young people present behavioral difficulties arising from their condition; many have communication difficulties and use Makaton signing as their primary form of communication.

What is the purpose of the role:

The role of Teacher of Technology at Severndale Specialist Academy is responsible for the implementation and delivery of an appropriately broad, balanced, relevant and differentiated curriculum for students across the Academy, including the delivery of accreditation for Design and Technology and Food Technology.
