Teacher of Islamic Studies B

Job Scope

The role of the Teacher of Islamic Studies B is to implement and teach the Ministry's Curriculum of Islamic Studies in the UAE for Muslim pupils from FS1 to Year 13.

Main duties and responsibilities

- Create syllabuses for each of the courses assigned in line with the Ministry of Education requirements for Islamic Studies B
- Plan, initiate and guide the units of Islamic Studies B which involve knowledge and understanding of Islam and other major world religions
- Foster the understanding of religious traditions and appreciation of the cultural differences in the UAE today
- Create and evaluate assessments of each pupil's work and keep records updated
- Communicate regularly and constructively with pupils and parents
- Use teaching methods engaging pupils, stimulating intellectual curiosity including the use of effective questioning, presentation and resources
- Set high expectations for pupils' behaviour, establishing and maintaining a good standard of behaviour management through well focused teaching and through positive and productive relationships
- Contribute to the extra-curricular activities programme
